

## **DISCIPLESHIP ASSIGNMENT #2**

You will need a notebook and paper, or a computer, or both.

Be sure you have listened to parts 1-10 of the discipleship series.

If you have not completed Assignment #1, it is really not a good idea to start on Assignment #2.

1. Listen to: Series 109 "But I Don't Have Time To Pray!" (only two sermons; listen to each sermon in one sitting) and Series 126 "Learning to Hear God's Voice" (only two sermons; listen to each sermon in one sitting). As you listen, follow along in scripture, pray in the Spirit and take notes.

2. Read James a minimum of 50 times. While reading, pray in the Spirit. Do not take notes or do word studies until beginning with the 50<sup>th</sup> reading.

3. Joshua was faithful, even in battle (Exodus 17:8-16); he ended up leading Israel. Elisha was faithful & sought for a double-portion of Elijah's spirit (anointing); he ended up stepping in to Elijah's role (2 Kings 2)

The Apostles were faithful and ended up continuing the work of Jesus.

Timothy was faithful; he ended up continuing the work of Paul (2 Timothy).

A disciple will be faithful; when the doors are open, you'll be here on time, ready to participate and help. Develop the mindset that you are the pastor. [Viewers will log on or watch archived services, setting aside time].
