

**The enemy hastes *Hupomone***

*Hupomone* (Gk. 5281) – Translated “patience” 29x.

A compound word: *hupo*, “under, to be under something that’s very heavy” and *mone*, “to stay, to remain, to continually abide in one place” (John 15:7)

Together, *hupo* and *mone* mean “persevere, remain under as to **things** or **circumstances**.” Endurance. Perseverance.

In Scripture, *hupomone* is associated with hope and refers to “the quality of character which does not allow one to surrender to circumstances or succumb to trial.”
