

HEALING AND GOD'S WORD

God's desire for people in their physical bodies is revealed in Gen 1-2.

Gen. 1:26-27, 31, 2:7, 3:17

Healing is the process by which all forms of sickness, disease, injury and affliction are removed from the sum total of the human body for the purpose of sustaining its existence. However, healing cannot and will never eliminate the corruption introduced to the human body by Adam's sin that is revealed in Genesis chapter three. Removal of the Genesis chapter three corruption will only take place at the return of Jesus as described in 1 Corinthians 15:44-54. Therefore, healing cannot permanently prevent physical death; it can only sustain the human body until the corruption makes it impossible for the body to continue functioning.
