- (1) **Prov. 22:6** Parents are not responsible for how their child turns out, but they are responsible for how their child is trained.
- (2) **Joshua 6:1-5, 10, 15-16, 20 & Psalm 46:10** Can you be silent in the battle? Too many feel they must always say something. Waiting in silence can be just as critical as shouting, for in those times of solitude is when you will most clearly hear My voice.
- (3) **Isaiah 54:17** You may know Isaiah 54:17 and confess it, but if Satan's weapons are still prospering then something is wrong somewhere, and it cannot be God or His word.
- (4) **John 17:17** You cannot believe truth that you have rejected as true.
- (5) **John 4:13-19 & Galatians 6:1-2** God would give you more insight into the lives of other people if you were spiritually mature enough not to use that information to hurt or embarrass, or allow it to alter your feelings for the people.
